- Applicants submitting documentation of service on vessels that are of a configuration or in a service other than that of a standard class commercial vessel (e.g., mobile offshore drilling units, self-propelled dredges, integrated tug/barge units, etc.) must submit a copy of the vessel's certificate of inspection.
- Days of service are calculated in calendar days. Days of service may not be calculated by totaling command hours and dividing by eight.
