

## INVESTIGATION STATUS REPORT

### EVENT

On May 21, 2020, while moored at Oakland 37, the M/V THALASSA AVRA suffered some damage due to interaction with passing vessels. The passing vessels were the M/V HYUNDAI NEPTUNE and the M/V HANOVER EXPRESS. The damage consisted of parted lines and possibly contact with a container crane. Both Board-licensees aboard the passing vessels underwent post-incident chemical testing.
