PEC Chairman's Report to the BOPC July 27th, 2023

The Pilot Evaluation Committee met on July 19th 2023. The members present were Captains Ruff, Wehr and myself. Captains Aune and Slack were absent.

Agenda item A:

The four active trainees include Burns, Meyer, Olmsted and Pascucci. The trainee's range of time in the program span from 15 months to 33 months.

All trainees have First Class Pilotage endorsement for unlimited tonnage upon San Francisco Bay issued by the Coast Guard on their federal license's. All trainees are handling in all areas.

Trainee's Burns, Olmsted and Pascucci are in the evaluation stage of training.

Trainee Meyer has been moved into the evaluation stage of training. This means he will be expected to safely pilot all ships without coaching from the licensed pilot. The licensed pilot is only expected to intervene to keep the ship safe.

As PEC Chair I would like to recommend that the Board vote to approve Captain Dan Bridgman to temporarily replace Captain Drew Aune on PEC until Captain Aune returns to work from medical disability leave.

In closed session, all trainees were individually interviewed and counseled on their progress in the training program. All of the trainees are progressing at their own rates.

The next PEC meeting is scheduled for August 16th 2023 at 0730 in this office.
