I am charged with investigating events where there may have been damage caused by a ship in cases where a state-license pilot was onboard. My only concern is whether there was misconduct on the part of the pilot.

I am following up on our phone call recently wherein I inquired of any damage caused by the M/V TURICUM coming alongside berth 21 when they lost their engines on July 24, 2023.

On that phone call, my impression was that whatever damage was caused by the ship laying alongside was minimal. Our investigator, Michael O'Callaghan, could not identify the damage when he visited your facility on July 31.

Would you please confirm if there was damage and the estimate or cost of repair, if any?
