


The Board of Pilot Commissioners for the Bays of San Francisco, San Pablo, and Suisun ("Board") received your attorney Edwin Bradley's letter on October 23, 2025 petitioning the Board pursuant to Government Code section 11521 to reconsider its September 25, 2025 decision to adopt Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Juliet Cox's July 22, 2025 proposed decision in its entirety.

Although that decision of the Board was set to become final on October 31, 2025, I granted a stay of the deadline for the Board to consider your petition for reconsideration by the statutorily available ten days to November 10, 2025. On November 5, 2025, the Board conducted a special meeting to discuss and potentially act on the petition for reconsideration. Notice of that special meeting was published on October 31, 2025, and was provided to your attorney the same day.

At its special meeting on November 5, 2025, the Board considered your petition for reconsideration and voted unanimously to deny the petition pursuant to Government Code section 11521. Therefore, the Board's September 25, 2025 decision to adopt the ALJ's proposed decision is now final as of that date.
